

DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: Arizona Department of Water Resources' progress report concerning the development of a cone of depression test in the San Pedro River watershed.

The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") is filing this progress report to update the Court and parties regarding ADWR's plans for further work on the development of a cone of depression test within the San Pedro River watershed. ADWR believes that this information may be relevant to the "Motion for Status Conference to Schedule Evidentiary Hearing Concerning Implementation of Cone of Depression Testing" filed by Freeport Minerals Corporation on June 14, 2015, and recently filed responses thereto.

In ADWR's opinion, a cone of depression test can best be evaluated in its application rather than as an abstract concept. Therefore, ADWR has been working on a project to demonstrate the results of applying certain cone of depression tests to wells located within the San Pedro River watershed. This demonstration project will also include application of Geographic Information System ("GIS") techniques to create abstracts of water rights for *de minimis* uses in the San Pedro River watershed that are not part of the *Sands Group of Cases* (contested case no. W1-11-19) and that may be used in the preparation of a preliminary hydrographic survey report pursuant to Court Order filed June 27, 2016. Water right abstracts in contested case no. W1-11-19 are being prepared by the Special Master. See Special Master's Order filed June 17, 2016.

The attached figure displays the extent of the demonstration project area, which consists of the two most southerly townships in the San Pedro River watershed (Townships 23 and 24 South). This area contains a mix of water use types including domestic, irrigation, stockponds, stockwatering, municipal and other uses, except industrial and mining. Within this area, ADWR plans to conduct cone of depression testing using both the existing USGS numerical model (MODFLOW) and an analytical method such as WINFLOW, which ADWR described most recently in its progress report filed April 4, 2016.

ADWR expects to complete the demonstration project and file a report by December 31, 2016. Results for both of the cone of depression methods will be presented and discussed and final recommendations for a cone of depression test will be made. The report also will present and discuss the results of applying GIS to create water right abstracts for *de minimis* uses that are not part of the *Sands Group of Cases* (W1-11-19).


