3 Pursuant to the Minute Entry filed on November 30, 2017, and corrected by the
4 Order dated December 7, 2017, ADWR hereby provides notice of filing a map identifying
5 wells that provide sources of water for potential water rights listed in WFR 113-12-BD-
6 004 and any new wells listed as sources of water in any new or amended Statements of
7 Claimant filed by the Bayless and Berkalew Company that are located within the Subflow
8 Zone for the San Pedro River watershed.

9 The map and inset table show the names and locations of well point(s) of diversion
10 that were verified during ADWR's August 26, 2018 field visit to the subject parcels in
11 comparison to the locations listed in WFR 113-12-BD-004 and the locations listed in
12 ADWR's Well Registry records. ADWR's field-verified GPS coordinates for the wells
13 are represented as red, yellow, or blue dots on the map. The points of diversion listed in
14 WFR 113-12-BD-004 are represented as green asterisks on the map; these locations were
15 determined using aerial imagery at the time. ADWR's Well Registry database uses a
16 cadastral system to determine each well's location, so the Registry locations may only be
17 accurate to the center of a 10-acre quarter, 40-acre quarter or 160- acre quarter; the
18 Registry locations are represented as red stars on the map. As a result of comparing the
19 locations listed in these three different sources, several sites on the map have more than
20 one reported location.


21 The Department was unable to verify four of the wells during the site visit; those
22 four wells are identified in the comments section of the table. No new wells were located
23 during the site visit.
