All,

It looks like we may need at least three more people to help with the stocking. As of now, we are planning on leaving the Phoenix office at around 6:30 am on October 18, and so should arrive at the Muleshoe Headquarters at about 11:00

am. We will then likely transfer about half of the fish from our large fish transport container to two coolers. The coolers will be placed in a UTV and driven to the lower release site at the bottom of reach 2 (our monitoring reach 2); three people needed. The fish will then be transferred to buckets and carried down to the stream, tempered, and stocked.

The fish that were left in the large transport container will be driven (using our truck) to near the stocking site near Wildcat Canyon; three people. From the place where we normally park to do monitoring for reach 1, fish will be transferred to buckets and carried down to the stream, tempered and stocked.

Clay, or one of the other AGFD people will actually leave the office earlier (about 5 am) and transport Gila chub to the TNC Lower San Pedro River Preserve, to augment the population in the pond. After that he will drive to the Muleshoe and help with the spikedace and loach minnow stocking.

Please note that the AGFD CAP program in coordination with USFWS, TNC & BLM will be stocking fish into Muleshoe CMA the week of October 17th, 2011.

We are still working on the logistical details regarding arrival at Muleshoe HQ as well as the need for possible assistance for the stocking operation. The stocking will likely occur on the 18th; the fish collected from Bubbling Ponds Native Fish Conservation Facility on the 17th. This stocking will be limited to Hot Springs Canyon and we will not be using a helicopter to deliver fish.
