**Subject:** Annual Muleshoe Native Fish Monitoring

All,

We had scheduled the annual fish monitoring in the Muleshoe waters for the week of September 19. I was wondering if people would be willing to do the monitoring over the weekend of the 17 and 18 instead, and maybe into Monday?
