Sir:

Upon the recommendation of the Major General Commanding the Army as being no longer required for military purposes, and at the instance of the Honorable the Secretary of the Interior I have the honor to recommend that the Military Reservation of Fort Mojave, Arizona be transferred and turned over to the Department of the Interior for Indian school purposes, under the Act of July 21, 1882, entitled "An Act to provide additional Industrial Training Schools for Indian youth and authorizing the use of unoccupied military barracks for such purpose." (22 Stats 181.)
