The President:

I have the honor to recommend that the military reservation of Fort Marcy, New Mexico, declared by Executive Order of August 26, 1868, turned over to the Secretary of the Interior for disposition by Executive Order of October 7, 1891, and again declared by Executive Order of November 12, 1891, be placed under the control of the Secretary of the Interior for disposition under the act of Congress, approved July 5, 1884, which provides:

"That whenever, in the opinion of the President of the United States, the lands, or any portion of them, included within the limits of any military reservation heretofore or hereafter declared, have become or shall become useless for military purposes, he shall cause the same or so much thereof as he may designate, to be placed under the control of the Secretary of the Interior for disposition as hereinafter provided; and shall cause to be filed with the Secretary of the Interior a notice thereof."

This reservation is located in the city of Santa Fe, New Mexico, and embraces an area of 17 acres, 3,425 square yards and 2.656 square feet, more or less. It has become useless for military purposes.
