Hi Jack,

For Friday's meeting I have a few items to discuss with you. The first is a follow up on the data request we submitted last May, for any and all BLM documentation that supports the SPRNCA reservation boundary (copies of maps, land surveys, etc.). The BLM data is intended to support the GIS final boundary given to ADWR on Aug. 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009 which the report is based on. It is still relevant to document how the boundary was developed and the acreage involved. This boundary data is to be included in our Appendix C2.

The second issue involves the railroad ROW and any new updates or changes to the SPRNCA landownership (pending acquisitions) we should be aware of. The ROW issue may end up being addressed at a later time, but any new data or progress on this matter should be analyzed before the report goes out.

The third issue is a follow up on the river issue and the centerline. Checking to see what BLM's position is regarding changes to the meandering San Pedro river.
