NOTICE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

SIERRA VISTA

Notice is hereby given by Green Cattle Company, a corporation, that it has claimed and appropriated all the waters of the San Pedro River in Cochise County, State of Arizona, which appropriation was actually made in the year 1906, and has continued ever since, for the uses and purposes of irrigation, watering stock and other beneficial purposes. That the point of diversion of said water, at which this notice is posted is a point on the San Pedro River, about 200 feet north, and 720 feet east of the Southwest corner of the west half of the southwest quarter of section 22 Township 23 South Range 22 East. That at the time of said actual appropriation said Company built a dam at said point, and a ditch from a point immediately above said dam, being the point of diversion, thence in a northerly direction to a point about 160 feet west of the Northeast corner of the west half of the southwest quarter of said section 22, above described, thence to a point about 200 feet from the north boundary of Section 22 aforesaid thence east to a point about 200 feet west of the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of said section 22, thence in a northerly direction to a point where it empties into the San Pedro River. Said ditch is about five miles in length. That said dam was, ever since has been and is intended to form a reservoir, to store the said waters, so that they will flow through said ditch, and be conserved, and said Company intends to maintain the same and the said ditch. That the point of diversion and the terminal point is above specifically stated.
