Subject: Document Identified in Recent Disclosures re: disposition of Federal Military Reservations

Lee, in reviewing the United States' most recently produced documents, I came upon a reference to a document that appears to have some relevance to the four issues presented in this case, which I have not yet been able to locate in the documents thus far produced. The reference is contained in a document from the Arizona Game and Fish Commission to the Chief of Engineers of the United States Army, dated August 28, 1947. On the first page of that document (Bates stamped USFH 2038), there is a reference to a 1910 publication of the Government Printing Office entitled "United States Military Reservations, National Cemeteries and Military Parks." I have looked through your index of documents produced and cannot find this one. Does the government have a copy of this document, or has it already been made available?

From the quotation given in the AGFC's letter, the reference document appears directly relevant to issues pertaining to the 1949 disposal of Fort Huachuca. I would like to obtain a copy via this informal request, if possible, rather than serving a formal request to produce. Thanks for your attention to this.
