Memorandum for Regional Forester:

I have just returned from an inspection of the Caliumo Primitive Area in company with Mr. Miller of your office. Mr. Miller concurs with me in that the fire situation in that country warrants the eventual creation of a fire guard with telephone connections. The visibility from either the Graham lookouts or those on the Cornade is such that a fire in the bottom of Rattlesnake, Kilberg or Redfield Canyons could assume Class C proportions before being discovered.

The old Powers place in Sec. 13, T. 9 S., R. 19 E., is the logical place for creating a guard cabin and also an administrative cabin for the use of the rangers. This site was formerly held under the mining laws but is at present abandoned and is being posted with public service site notices. I should like to make an administrative withdrawal of it, if you believe that this is possible within the Primitive Area and if you otherwise concur. Should you agree with me on this, the necessary report will be prepared.

Mr. Miller can furnish you full details of the matter.
