1. Dates of acquisition I can get from our records folks in spreadsheet format.
2. The railroad ROW has been problematic. ADWR may have it since they have been researching Cochise county records - I'll check. In any case, I was told by David Keadle that they will be using acreage from the county for their submission to the SM.
3. I can make a map of the post-designation parcels, labeled with the acquisition dates - it will take a day or two.
4. I can get the total acreage inside the boundary.
