Hi, Lee---

After finally resolving the several map and certification requirements that the Headquarters Office has decided are necessary for transmissions of NLCS unit boundary maps and legal descriptions to Congress, the San Pedro boundary map and legal description are on their way to WO. I don't have an affidavit that they were sent, though I could create one. Should I? I do have a certification signed by Jim Kenna and by the cadastral survey manager saying they are accurate. They will be sent to ADWR next week as a comment to their report that will be sent out for comment tomorrow. As far as the cover letter for the package, you probably remember that I asked your opinion on whether to mention that there was no confirmed receipt of the original map and description by the Sec or by Congress. You suggested that it wasn't necessary, but Jim K wanted to include it, so in the end we said the documents were sent to WO on Dec 6, 1989, "but the status of further transmittals is unclear." I hope that doesn't create a problem.

If you have a format for an affidavit you'd like me to prepare for the confirmation of the mailing of the packet to WO, perhaps you could send it.

Have an excellent 4th. I'll miss the fireworks on the Mall, the annual Capitol Fourth production from the West Lawn of the Capitol, and especially jockeying for position with 200,000 other patriotic spectators.
