Suggestions for Completing Proof of Appropriation of Water Form

This is the final report required of a holder of a permit to appropriate public waters. Upon approval of this report and the receipt of the proper fee the Department shall be ready to issue a Certificate of Water Right.

The Proof of Appropriation of Water is a series of statements of the appropriator, under oath, which are corroborated by the affidavits of two witnesses. This form should be filled in carefully, in a manner that will describe completely the project as actually constructed, giving the number of stock being watered and the quantity of water used under stockwatering permits; giving, in case of irrigation, the number of acres of land actually irrigated and the quantity of water used; and giving the full extent of use under appropriations for whatever other purposes. The practice of merely copying this information from the permit is not proper and should not be followed.

The affidavits must be made before a Notary Public or other officer qualified to administer oaths.

Excerpt from State Water Code: "At the time of submission of proof of appropriation . . . the department shall collect . . . two dollars for recording the water right certificate in the office of the county recorder, together with an additional fee of twelve cents for each acre of irrigated lands up to and including one hundred acres, and ten cents per acre for each in excess of one hundred acres . . . The minimum fee for any claimant in such instances shall be two dollars fifty cents. The department shall also collect a fee of five dollars for any other character of claim to water."



Gentlemen:

Andrew L. Bettwy, State Land Commissioner, Phoenix, Arizona, submits the following item. It is hoped that you will find it newsworthy.

E. G. Salazar, Klondyke, Arizona, has filed with Commissioner Bettwy, two applications for permits to construct reservoirs and store water for beneficial use.

The reservoir sites are within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 7 South, Range 18 East, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Pinal County, Arizona.

Both diversion points (reservoirs) and places of use (at reservoirs) are on State land.

The total capacity of each reservoir to be 1/2 acre foot and 1/3 acre foot, respectively.

The source of water supply being Browns Draw and Wire Corral Mesa Draw, both tributaries of Aravaipa Canyon and of San Pedro River. Both sources are within the Gila River watershed.

Beneficial use in both instances is Stockwatering, and the amount of water requested for this purpose is 91,250 gallons per annum from each reservoir.

The town nearest the places of use is Klondyke, and the Post Office serving those living in that vicinity is Klondyke Rural Station, Willcox, Arizona.

Suggestions for Completing Proof of Appropriation of Water Form

This is the final report required of a holder of a permit to appropriate public waters. Upon approval of this report and the receipt of the proper fee the Department shall be ready to issue a Certificate of Water Right.

The Proof of Appropriation of Water is a series of statements of the appropriator, under oath, which are corroborated by the affidavits of two witnesses. This form should be filled in carefully, in a manner that will describe completely the project as actually constructed, giving the number of stock being watered and the quantity of water used under stockwatering permits; giving, in case of irrigation, the number of acres of land actually irrigated and the quantity of water used; and giving the full extent of use under appropriations for whatever other purposes. The practice of merely copying this information from the permit is not proper and should not be followed.

The affidavits must be made before a Notary Public or other officer qualified to administer oaths.

Excerpt from State Water Code: "At the time of submission of proof of appropriation . . . the department shall collect . . . two dollars for recording the water right certificate in the office of the county recorder, together with an additional fee of twelve cents for each acre of irrigated lands up to and including one hundred acres, and ten cents per acre for each in excess of one hundred acres . . . The minimum fee for any claimant in such instances shall be two dollars fifty cents. The department shall also collect a fee of five dollars for any other character of claim to water."





Andrew L. Bettwy, State Land Commissioner, Phoenix, Arizona, submits the following item. It is hoped that you will find it newsworthy.

E. G. Salazar, Klondyke, Arizona, has filed with Commissioner Bettwy, two applications for permits to construct reservoirs and store water for beneficial use.

The reservoir sites are within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 7 South, Range 18 East, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Pinal County, Arizona.

Both diversion points (reservoirs) and places of use (at reservoirs) are on State land.

The total capacity of each reservoir to be 1/2 acre foot and 1/3 acre foot, respectively.

The source of water supply being Browns Draw and Wire Corral Mesa Draw, both tributaries of Aravaipa Canyon and of San Pedro River. Both sources are within the Gila River watershed.

Beneficial use in both instances is Stockwatering, and the amount of water requested for this purpose is 91,250 gallons per annum from each reservoir.

The town nearest the places of use is Klondyke, and the Post Office serving those living in that vicinity is Klondyke Rural Station, Willcox, Arizona.
