This is the final report required of a holder of a permit allowing appropriation of public waters. Upon arrival of this report and the receipt of the proper fee the Department shall be ready to issue a Certificate of Water Right.

The proof of Appropriation of Water is a series of statements of the appropriator, under oath, which are corroborated by the affidavits of two witnesses. This form should be filled in carefully, in a manner that will describe completely the project as actually constructed, giving the number of stock being watered and the quantity of water used under stockwatering permits; giving, in case of irrigation, the number of acres of land actually irrigated and the quantity of water used; and giving the full extent of use under appropriations for whatever other purposes. 

Dear Certificate Holder:

The Director of the Department of Water Resources is pleased to forward the enclosed Certificates of Water Right for your records. Each certificate is evidence of your right to use a given amount of public waters of the State for a certain beneficial use at the specified location. You may wish to record this certificate with your County Recorder for the county in which the water right is located. A copy of the water right certificate is maintained in the official records of the Department.

Please note that the right to the use of water as evidenced by a certificate is not absolute; the basis, measure, and limit of any water right granted under provisions of the Public Water Code is the amount actually put to the stated beneficial use, but never more than the amount stated in the certificate. In addition, your water right is given a date of priority, the filing date of the original application, as a means of ranking the water right in relation to all other water rights within a specific watershed. Your water right is subject to prior-vested water rights. For purposes of management of the available water resource in times of scarcity, water rights senior in time to your water right could have "first call" on the available supply of public water; senior water rights could prohibit your use of the water resource until their water rights are satisfied.

The watershed in which your water right is located is undergoing a Superior Court judicial proceeding. This proceeding, called a "water rights adjudication," is a quantification and ranking of all water rights located within the watershed. To participate in the adjudication, you must file a claim with the superior court. If you have not yet taken action to join the court proceedings, you may wish to do so to protect your water right.

Questions concerning the nature of your water rights may be addressed to the Operations Division. Questions concerning the water rights adjudication proceedings may be addressed to the Department's Adjudication Division. The Department cannot give legal advice. If you are concerned about how the adjudication will affect your rights, you may wish to consult an attorney experienced in water rights matters.



The Director of the Department of Water Resources is pleased to forward the enclosed Permits to Appropriate for your records. These permits allow you to construct the necessary works, take steps to apply the water to the requested beneficial use at the specified location, and proceed to perfect your appropriations towards certificates of water right. These actions must be completed with reasonable diligence, as required by A.R.S. § 45-160. A duplicate copy of this permit is maintained in the official records of the Department.

The permission to use water evidenced by these permits is not absolute. The basis, measure, and limit of any water right granted under provisions of the Public Water Code is the amount actually put to the stated beneficial use, but never more than the amount stated in the permits. Your permits also have a date of priority, usually the filing date of the original applications, as a means of ranking your use in relation to all other water rights within a specific watershed. For purposes of management of the available water resource in times of scarcity, water rights senior in time to your use could have "first call" on the available supply of public water; senior water rights could prohibit your use of the water resource until their water rights are satisfied.

The watershed in which your proposed use is located is currently undergoing a court mandated review of all water uses located within the watershed. This determination, called a "water rights adjudication," is a superior court proceeding which will result in a decree issued by the court quantifying and ranking all water rights. Your application may not yet be included in the water rights adjudication proceedings. If you have not yet taken action to join the court proceedings, you may wish to do so to protect your rights as a permit holder.

Also enclosed are Proof of Appropriation and Affidavit of Appropriator forms. These two forms must be completed and filed with the Department of Water Resources for each permit after the means of diversion or storage have been applied to the beneficial use. The Affidavit of Appropriator must be notarized and supported by the affidavit of two witnesses. You may submit attachments with the Proof.

Questions concerning the nature of your permits and the water rights adjudication proceedings may be addressed to the Department, but the Department cannot provide legal advice. If you are concerned about how the adjudication will affect your rights, you may wish to consult an attorney experienced in water rights matters.



The Bureau of Land Management, Safford District ("BLM"), filed 17 applications for appropriative permits, in the San Pedro River watershed, which are described in the enclosed summary sheet.

These applications have been referred to me to conduct a hearing, on the protests filed by the San Carlos Irrigation Project ("Project"), and submit a recommendation to the Director, who will make the decision to approve or reject the applications.

I would like to schedule hearings on these applications beginning in May, 1994, in Tucson.

The parties will need to prepare evidentiary documents, technical information and historical data they wish to present at the hearing. The BLM must be prepared to establish each item contained in the applications with specific information. Estimates or approximations previously provided must be better defined. Particular attention should be given to the nature of the water source, amounts of water stored, reservoir capacities, and proposed beneficial uses.

The BLM must be prepared to present evidence pertaining to its applications' lack of conflict with the claimed water rights of the Project, lack of a menace to public safety, and lack of adverse impacts on the interests and welfare of the public. These are statutory standards.

The Project must be prepared to present evidence of the nature and extent of its claimed water rights and of the potential impact of these applications on its water rights.

2. Some of the applications could be consolidated for hearing. Which applications could be consolidated and heard in the same hearing?


3. Many of these applications are for small amounts of water or are for claimed historic uses. What is the possibility that the parties could resolve some, if not all, of these matters without a hearing?







Reference is made to Application No. 33-95397, 33-95398, 33-95399, 33-95400, 33-95401, 33-95441, 33-95444, 33-95445, 33-95446, 33-95447, 33-95449, 33-95450, and 33-95454, filed by Bureau of Land Management, Safford District, 425 East 4th Street, Safford, Arizona 85546, a permit to appropriate public water of the State of Arizona and/or construct a reservoir and store water for beneficial use.

If this Application is approved it would deprive the Indian and Non-Indian water users of the San Carlos Irrigation Project, Bureau of Indian Affairs, water that has been used on certain of the Indian lands from immemorial time. This is evidenced by the United States District Court in the Decree entered June 29, 1935 known as Globe Equity No. 59 (Gila Decree).

Waters of the Gila River and it's tributaries have long been over appropriated and in most water years the irrigation water is in extremely short supply and much of the Project lands must remain idle because of the insufficient water supply.

It is believed that the approval of this Application would result in the diminution of water of the Gila River and thus the rights of the San Carlos Irrigation Project water users would be adversely affected.

Waters of the Gila River and it's tributaries are delivered directly to Project lands located in Townships 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 South, and Ranges 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 East, and to reservation lands lying in Townships 1 and 2 South, Ranges 1

and 2 East. All such waters are delivered to the described lands to the extent of all such water available. All deliveries are for irrigation purposes. The points of diversion are located in the NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 11 East (Ashurst-Hayden Dam), near the southwest corner of Section 7, Township 4 South, Range 7 East (Olberg Dam); in Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 2 East (Upper Gila Crossing Dam); and in Section 16, Township 2 South, Range 2 East (Lower Gila Crossing Dam).






