SUBJECT: Placing Fort Huachuca in an Inactive Status

TO: Commanding Officer  
Fort Huachuca, Arizona

1. Your station was placed in the category of inactive on 31 January 1946.

2. It is desired that you take the necessary action to curtail all activities consistent with your reduced work load. The action to be completed by 30 April 1946.

3. Present War Department plans are that your station will remain in the inactive category pending determination of Post War Utilization. In the absence of definite and specific instructions it is to be assumed that your station will be placed in an inactive status in such a manner so you will be prepared to receive 10,473 troops upon a 60 days notice.

4. In addition to the action to be taken as directed in Chapter 2, ASF Manual M-706, dated April 1945, there is furnished as Inclosure No. 1, hereto supplemental instructions for your necessary action and guidance.

5. If any instructions contained herein are not understood, or if prompt disposition is not given, notify this headquarters, attention: Plans and Operations Division (SPRVO), with the least practicable delay.

6. There are inclosed fifty (50) copies of WD AGO Form R-5035. It is desired that the following action be taken with regard to these forms:

a. Four (4) copies will be made out as of 2400, Friday of each week and mailed so as to reach this headquarters, attention: Plans and Operations Division, on the following Monday.

b. The column headed "Estimated Date of Completion" will be divided into two (2) columns, one of which will indicate the estimated date of completion for each item and the other will indicate the percentage of completion for each item as of 2400, Friday of each week, sample inclosed.

c. The form will be forwarded with a letter of transmittal covering other pertinent facts.
