Dear Mr. Udall:

In response to your inquiry concerning civilian and military strength at Fort Huachuca, I enclose a detailed breakout of our working population. This, of course, excludes all dependents (unless they happen to be on a post-connected payroll) and also all concessionaire personnel.

Our total daytime population is approximately 13,100, and total nighttime population is about 10,400.

Please be reminded that around 3,000 military personnel (excluding dependents) have been withdrawn from here since July 1960 for the Berlin buildup, Southeast Asia, mobility, test, etc., and have not returned. This loss was partially offset last fall by the relocation of some 1600 troops to Fort Huachuca from Forts Chaffee, Bliss and Hood.
