



## INTRODUCTION

Fort Huachuca is a major employer in the state of Arizona. With a workforce in excess of 11,400 military and civilian employees, the installation is the largest employer in southern Arizona. As both an employer and consumer, Fort Huachuca plays a major role in the overall economic health of the state and, in particular, Cochise County.

As the post has grown from its 1877 cavalry beginnings, its impact has also grown in national defense and the economy. Established to protect border settlers, Fort Huachuca is now home to the worldwide Army Communications Command, the Army Intelligence Center and School, the Army Electronic Proving Ground and the Department of Defense Joint Test Element of the Joint Tactical Communications Office.

Support of these missions and others requires the installation to be a consumer of goods and services in addition to an employer. Many members of the workforce live with their families on Fort Huachuca, making the post a kind of small city. In this sense, the post must provide the same kinds of services for its residents as other Arizona communities. Many of the members of the post's workforce are involved in providing such services as fire and police protection, medical and hospital care, buildings and grounds maintenance, roads, recreation and other services designed to maintain quality of life and to promote a healthy workforce.

This impact statement provides a profile of Fort Huachuca as an Arizona employer and consumer for fiscal year 83 (October 1, 1982, through September 30, 1983). Figures from previous years are used in many categories for comparison purposes.

The figures released in the FY83 impact statement for Fort Huachuca reflect the continuing stable impact by the installation on the state's economy.

## POPULATION

More than 11,400 military and civilians are employed by Fort Huachuca activities. The FY83 military population figures reflect an increase from previous years that is attributable to an increased student load at the Army Intelligence Center and School, the largest troop activity on Fort Huachuca.

While many of the military assigned to Fort Huachuca reside on post with their families, many personnel live in the neighboring communities of Sierra Vista and Huachuca City. Other military and civilian personnel live in other communities in Cochise County and some in Tucson in Pima County.



While the Fort Huachuca workforce figures reflect the variances seen in previous years, they also reflect the continued stability of the workforce. When the US Bureau of Commerce economic multiplier is applied to the 11,407 workforce, Fort Huachuca supports more than 25,400 jobs in Arizona, in addition to those on post. The economic multiplier applied to the civilian workforce is 2.94, and 1.622 is applied to the military.



## CONSUMER DATA

In support of its day to day operations, Fort Huachuca is a consumer of goods and services, just as civilian communities are consumers. In addition to those goods and services the installation purchases that are common to civilian communities, Fort Huachuca is a consumer of high technology industrial goods and services because of the missions of the major activities located on the installation.

The US Army Communications Command, with a worldwide mission of providing and managing communications, is headquartered on Fort Huachuca. The Army's Electronic Proving Ground and the Department of Defense Joint Test Element are located on the installation. Both of these activities are concerned in the development and testing of tactical communications-electronics equipment. Another major activity located on the installation is the Army's Intelligence Center and School, which has an average daily student population in excess of 1,200.


The relatively free electromagnetic environment and the year-round testing climate are responsible for the location of these activities, with their common communications-electronics missions, at Fort Huachuca.

As a consumer, Fort Huachuca relies upon Arizona business and industry to provide certain necessary products and services for the installation's operations and missions. As seen in the following chart, purchases by the post in the state of Arizona totaled \$65 million in FY83. When added to the pay and other categories of expenditures, Fort Huachuca expended \$348.7 million in FY83, with 81 percent (\$283.3 million) in the state of Arizona. Overall expenditures by the post show an increase of \$35.7 million from the previous fiscal year, and Arizona expenditures show an increase of \$46.5 million from FY82.


When the economic multiplier is applied to the post's expenditures, the total is expressed as \$840.1 million, compared with \$628.4 million in FY82 and \$558 million in FY81. A 3.8 multiplier is applied to civilian wages, purchases and other expenditures, and a 1.662 multiplier is applied to military pay to determine these figures.



Of the purchases made by the post during FY83, approximately \$1.9 million were spent on construction, alteration and renovation of facilities on post. Not included in the installation expenditures is the \$19.4 million construction contract for the expansion of Libby Army Airfield, which is funded by the National Guard Bureau.


Fort Huachuca continues to increase its purchases within the state of Arizona. The \$65 million in purchases in the state for FY83 were made in the trade centers listed in the following chart. Fort Huachuca's purchases in other states amounted to \$65.4 million, a decrease from the \$76.2 million expended outside of Arizona during FY82.

Purchases of goods and services in Cochise County by the post nearly doubled during FY83, reflecting the tendency of contractors to establish local offices.

Forty-two percent (or \$27 million) of the total purchases made in Arizona was made from small, disadvantaged and minority businesses.



In addition to purchases and wages, Fort Huachuca is responsible for other revenues for Arizona. Because many Fort Huachuca-sponsored children receive their education in the civilian community, Federal impact funds are provided to defray some of the community educational costs. Because Fort Huachuca provides certain services and benefits to retired military personnel and their family members, many retirees and their families reside near the installation, and their retirement pay contributes to the state economy. And because many civilian personnel retire from Fort Huachuca and remain in the state, their retirement pay also contributes to the Arizona economy.

## EDUCATION

Nearly 2,100 children living on Fort Huachuca attend schools on the installation or in neighboring communities. Those children of kindergarten through eighth grade ages attend Fort Huachuca Accommodation Schools, which are jointly operated by the state of Arizona and the Department of Education. Some 529 children who live on post attend high school in Sierra Vista.

Federal impact funds, which supplement state funds to operate schools in the area, totaled \$2.18 million for the 1982-1983 school year.

Impact funds for the 1982-1983 school year reflect an increase from the \$1.34 million reported for the 1981-1982 school year. The increase in funds can be attributed primarily to the increase in the number of military-sponsored students. Educational organizations in the community receive a greater amount of impact funding for children of military personnel than is received for children of civilian personnel. Communities which have reported receipt of impact funds in previous years which reported none this year include Benson and Douglas.

## MILITARY RETIREES


Military retirees contribute in many ways to the state economy. Not only do they spend their retirement pay in the state, many have found additional employment or even second careers. They normally pay property tax and income tax and they contribute in sales and use tax. Generally making few demands on the state's social systems, the military retiree makes a substantial contribution to the Arizona economy.





Data concerning civilian retirees in the state is obtained from the Office of Personnel Management, which did not report the number of civilian retirees to have increased from FY82. However, the Office of Personnel Management indicated that a 3.55 per cent inflation factor should be applied to civilian retiree pay. Hence, the number of civilian retirees reported in the FY83 statement is the same as reported for FY82, but the amount of their retirement pay is increased.

A 3.38 multiplier is applied to both state and local totals to reflect the impact of retired civilian pay on the Arizona economy.



## ANNEXATION

As a result of the 1971 annexation of Fort Huachuca by Sierra Vista, the post provides additional revenue for the state. The post's contributions in sales and use tax and gasoline tax enhance the Fort Huachuca impact on the Sierra Vista and Cochise County economy.


The impact of Fort Huachuca on the state extends beyond economy. Fort Huachuca, like other communities, is concerned for its population and endeavors to provide optimum living and working conditions, a clean environment and modern facilities for its residents and employees.

To this end, Fort Huachuca provides adult educational opportunities for its personnel, a wide variety of arts and crafts facilities, recreational activities, medical and dental care, a post exchange and commissary, and other facilities and services.

Fort Huachuca is a community concerned with the environment and the conservation of natural resources. Through the efforts of the post's Land and Game Management staff and because of Fort Huachuca's unique ecological systems, the installation abounds with fish and wildlife. Dedicated to habitat improvement, the post maintains land use and rare bird protection programs. Deer hunting and fishing opportunities are excellent.

In its concern for natural resources, Fort Huachuca endeavors to restrict its consumption of utilities to a level required for optimum efficiency. With the cooperation of the workforce and residents and the continued efforts of the installation engineers, Fort Huachuca's consumption of gas, electricity and propane fuels dropped from 1.53 billion BTUs in FY82 to 1.47 billion BTUs in FY83.
