

CHAPTER 17: DIRECTORATE OF ENGINEERING AND HOUSING*

1. Mission. The Directorate of Engineering and Housing (DEH) serves as principal adviser to and assists the United States Army Garrison Fort Huachuca (USAGFH) command and staff on all matters pertaining to facilities engineering and housing. Directs and provides operational control of all Fort Huachuca Facilities Engineering and Housing activities to include family housing; unaccompanied personnel services; contract supervision; inspection and administration; master planning; facilities space management; energy management for fixed facilities; fire protection and prevention; engineering supply; housing furnishings; forestry, fish, wildlife, land management, and historical preservation; environmental protection, restoration, and hazardous waste management; custodial, refuse, and recycling services; and real estate/real property control. Coordinates requirements for off-post facilities within the state of Arizona including reserve centers.

2. Environmental and Natural Resources Division.

a. New washracks were constructed and oil/water separators installed at eight locations which eliminated approximately 75 percent of the water pollutant discharges on post. A carbon absorption pretreatment unit was installed at the Libby Army Airfield (LAAF).

b. Fifteen underground storage tanks were removed from the installation. Phase I was completed for the remedial investigation of six Installation Restoration sites.

c. Cleanup of the "Splinter Village" fire site was completed. Asbestos-contaminated ash was buried in an asbestos landfill on the south range.

d. Surveys for mountain lion, bear, and turkey were continued in 1990. The density of large predators was excellent. Reintroduced Goulds turkeys were present in Huachuca, Garden, and Blacktail Canyons.

e. Steps were undertaken to protect the endangered Sanborn's long-nosed bat. Known roosts were placed off limits and fenced. The primary food source, the agave, was protected. Bats were confirmed on post from 10 August through 21 September. A contract was awarded to evaluate the effects of controlled burning on agave.
