SUMMARY OF MAJOR EVENTS AND PROBLEMS FY 61

1. General Information and Organization.

a. Combat Surveillance and Target Acquisition Training Command, during FY 1961, continued its Primary Mission of training personnel in the utilization, operation, and maintenance of CSTA equipment, without changes in the organizational concept. Mission as assigned to the command is included at Tab "A". Throughout the fiscal year, CSTATC remained a USCONARC Class I Activity under the command of Sixth US Army. CSTATC is organized as shown on attached chart at Tab "B".

b. Lieutenant Colonel Charles A. Brown, Infantry, who assumed command on 21 January 1960, remained in command.

2. Operations and Training.

a. Although the mission of this command remained the same, throughout the fiscal year, the training mission has continued to expand through the addition of new courses covering new CSTA equipment being added to the US Army inventory. Students enrolled and courses initiated during FY 61 are shown in a comparative chart FY 59 through FY 61 at Tab "C". The instructional mission of CSTATC is accomplished through the following instructional departments, who have the dual responsibility of acting as a special staff to the commander in matters pertaining to their technical fields:

(1) Aviation Department.

(a) At the start of FY 61, was organized into three (3) divisions; Operations, Maintenance, and Supply, with the role of supporting the airborne radar training of the Radar Department. In September of 1960 the Airborne Sensors Division was transferred to this department which was reorganized as shown at Tab "D".

(b) The Aviation Department, during the past fiscal year, was responsible for the conduct of training of the Aerial Surveillance Systems shown in chart at Tab "E", and in addition, conducted a special course on the AN/APS-94, for fourteen (14) individuals assigned to the US Army Aviation School, Fort Rucker, Alabama.
