1. PURPOSE. This regulation establishes the mission of the U. S. Army Electronic Proving Ground, Fort Huachuca, and its relationship to other commands pending the revision of AR 10-72, subject: Organization and Functions, U. S. Army Electronic Proving Ground, Fort Huachuca, Arizona.

2. MISSION.

- a. Provide and operate an Electronic Proving Ground to include an Electromagnetic Environmental Test Facility for the Army.
- b. Plan and conduct or participate in tests of electronic equipment and systems as directed.
- c. Plan, monitor, and participate in troop tests as directed.

3. ASSIGNMENT.

- a. The U. S. Army Electronic Proving Ground is a Class II Activity at Fort Huachuca, Arizona (DAGO No 2, 14 Jan 1954).
- b. Fort Huachuca, Arizona, is a Class II Installation (DAGO No 2, 14 Jan 1954 and DAGO No 35, 1 July 1957).
- c. In accordance with General Order Number 5, Headquarters, U. S. Army Materiel Command, dated 26 July 1962, the U. S. Army Electronic Proving Ground, Fort Huachuca, Arizona, and Fort Huachuca, Arizona, are under the command of Commanding General, U. S. Army Test and Evaluation Command.
