The Arizona Department of Water Resources is located in the Meridian Bank Building, 3550 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85012. The office building is on the west side of Central Avenue, between Osborn and Indian School Roads. To reach the parking structure, turn west on Columbus Avenue, the street just north of the Meridian Bank Building. The parking structure is on the south side of the road. Parking rates are \$1.00 per half hour with a maximum of \$7.00 per day. We regret that the Department cannot validate parking at this time. **ALTERNATIVE PARKING** is located across the street from the Meridian Bank visitor parking entrance on the north side of Columbus Avenue. Rates are \$.75 per half hour and \$6.50 per day. **Also**, there is a surface parking lot located on the northeast corner of Columbus and Central Avenues. The cost is only \$1.00 per day. Please take care crossing Central Avenue as there is road construction and heavy traffic.
