II. Reviews of Existing Rules Due in 2009

III. Rule Makings Terminated in 2008

The Santa Cruz AMA Rules Docket expired in August 2008, and ADWR opened a new Docket on August 1, 2008. The Adequacy Bill Rulemaking Docket expired in November of 2008, and ADWR opened a new Docket in December of 2008. The Assured Water Supply Technical Amendments Docket expired in April 2008, and ADWR expects to open a new Docket in December of 2008.
