**Subject:** Horse Camp Canyon - Aravaipa Creek

Hello,

Efforts to remove green sunfish from Horse Camp canyon, a tributary to Aravaipa Creek, have been ongoing and usually associated with the biannual fish monitoring. Recent efforts have focused on their removal as a separate action and resulted in 160 green sunfish being removed over a five day period. The fish were collected using Promar Collapsible minnow traps.
