



To the State Department of Water Resources, State of Arizona:

The United States of America acting by and through the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, hereby notifies you of the following existing water uses and estimated foreseeable future water uses on reserved lands within the San Pedro River Watershed of the Coronado National Forest for National Forest System purposes.

Current and estimated foreseeable water uses are listed as are the dates when the land was reserved from the Public Domain. These lands were withdrawn from the Public Domain September 26, 1910 by authority of the Organic Administration Act of June 4, 1897 (30 Stat. 34). In acquiring this land, the United States also acquired the right to the waters thereon to maintain favorable conditions of water flow and timber production.

The water made available by this development has been used by the United States Government, or its permittees, at the discretion of and for the United States Government, and is essential in carrying out land uses dependent on these waters. Without the availability of these waters, the use of the land for water production and timber production would be restricted and United States, owner of the land would be injured because of the subsequent inadequate watershed protection afforded and reduced volume of timber produced.



To the Arizona Water Commission, State of Arizona. The United States of America, acting by and through the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, hereby protests claims made by others to waters located on National Forest lands.

Mike Isley, Box 6, Bonita Rt., Willcox, Arizona 85643 has made claims of water rights for the following:

The United States Government, owner of the land on which located, is presently utilizing the water for livestock, wildlife and other purposes. These claimed waters have been captured and made available for livestock, wildlife, and other purposes by improvements owned by the United States Government.

The United States Government would be injured because the appropriation of this water by other than the landowner would interfere with the administration, management and use of the National Forest lands dependent on the waters in question.

The Forest Service has prepared filings under the appropriate State laws according to the prescribed procedures and schedule.

The claimant, Mike Isley is allowed use of these waters under a tenure permit solely for the purpose of utilizing the forage on National Forest lands by livestock. Conditions and limitations of this use are set by Grazing Permit No. 05-00713, dated 1/1/76 which was issued to, agreed to in writing by and is currently held by Michael G. & Elnora Isley, Clause 8d, of this permit, or contract, states:

"The permanent improvements constructed, or existing for use, in conjunction with this permit are the property of the United States Government, unless specifically designated otherwise, or covered by a cooperative agreement. They will not be removed, nor compensated for upon termination or revocation of this permit."

The water developments are included in the list of permanent improvements which is a part of the permit. Many of them are covered by Cooperative Agreements signed by the grazing permittees, each of which includes the statement that the water development (well, tank, spring box, etc.) is the property of the United States.
