

1 during the hearing record period. Those findings indicated that modifications to the proposed
2 plan were necessary. As a result of those findings and additional review by the Director, the
3 Director has made modifications to the proposed plan, as described below, as well as non-
4 substantive corrections of typographical errors.

5 **II. Modifications Made to Proposed Third Management Plan**

6 The following modifications have been made to the proposed plan:

7 A. Chapter 3, Water Demands and Supply

8 1. Table 3-1 Historical Water Demand by Sector was modified to correct for groundwater
9 use by the municipal sector during 2010 from 11,7587 to 9,913. This particular change resulted
10 in the following modifications:

11 a. Figure 3-2 Historical Supplies Used was updated to reflect the adjustments in
12 municipal groundwater use made to Table 3-1.

13 b. Figure 3-6 Historical Overdraft for the years 1985 – 2012, was altered to incorporate
14 the changes made to Table 3-1.

15 c. Table 3-2 Historical Water Demand by Sector was updated to include the changes
16 made to Table 3-1

17 2. Data for 2003 and 2004 in the “Offsets to Groundwater Pumping” column was added
18 to Table 3-2 Historical Water Demand by Sector.

19 3. Language was added on page 3-12; the final sentence now states that the average
20 annual overdraft in the Prescott AMA between 1985 and 2012 averaged approximately 9,000
21 acre-feet per year.
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2 **B. Chapter 5, Municipal Conservation Program**

3 A typographical error in the 2010 row of the “Groundwater Demand” column of Table 5-
4 1 Historical Municipal Demand and Committed Demand was corrected.

5 **C. Chapter 11, Water Budgets and Projections**

6 1. Minor changes were made to Table 11-1 Population Projection Comparison. The
7 table was updated to correct for typographical errors. Also, the order in which the items are
8 arranged was changed.

9 2. Language was modified on page 11-20 to read:

10 In 2011, the City of Prescott estimated the costs of the Big Chino importation
11 project to be approximately \$170 million. An estimated \$36 million was spent as
12 of the year 2011 on the Big Chino importation project for land acquisition,
13 engineering and design, hydrologic studies, and other costs. To construct the
14 pipeline and bring water into the PRAMA, an additional \$133 million is estimated
15 to be needed.

16 **III. Motions for Rehearing or Review**

17 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 45-571(C), a summary of this order, the management plan adopted
18 by this order and the Director’s findings with respect to matters considered during the public
19 hearing will be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the Prescott Daily
20 Courier newspaper, beginning on Wednesday, August 20, 2014. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 45-
21 114(C), any person may file a motion for rehearing or review of this order and the management
22 plan adopted by this order no later than Friday, September 26, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. Any motion for
23 rehearing or review must be filed with the Docket Supervisor, Arizona Department of Water
24 Resources, 3550 North Central Avenue, Second Floor, Phoenix, Arizona 85012.

25 **IV. Judicial Review**


This order shall become final for the purpose of judicial review as follows:

1 1. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 45-114(C), a party is not required to file a motion for rehearing
2 or review in order to exhaust administrative remedies and may seek judicial review of the Fourth
3 Management Plan once the director's decision becomes final.

4 2. If no person files a motion for rehearing or review within the time allowed by section
5 III of this order, this order shall become final for the purpose of judicial review on Saturday,
6 September 27, 2014.

7 3. If any person files a timely motion for rehearing or review, the Director will issue a
8 decision on the motion and may modify the management plan after rehearing or review. After
9 the Director issues decisions on all motions for rehearing or review, the Director will publish
10 notice that the management plan is final once each week for two consecutive weeks in the
11 Prescott Daily Courier. The notice will include a description of any modifications made after
12 rehearing or review. The management plan shall be final for the purpose of judicial review when
13 the notice is published for the second time.
