As Mayor of the Town of Chino Valley, I would like to express my strong opposition to any metering, restricting, or taxation of any privately owned wells in our county. Our residents (the great majority of whom are on private wells) are hard working citizens and retirees with limited incomes who need every penny to get by. Hookup costs alone would be an excessive burden to those citizens, let alone the monthly water bills. And placing more restrictions on the well drilling companies would drive even more small businessmen into bankruptcy.

Stormwater reclamation and the use of injection wells are the key to healthy aquifers, not the harassment of small businessmen and retirees.
