

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PROPOSED MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE PRESCOTT ACTIVE MANAGEMENT AREA FOR THE FOURTH MANAGEMENT PERIOD, 2010 TO 2020

Michael J. Lacey, Director of the Arizona Department of Water Resources, acting pursuant to sections 45-567 through 45-567.02 and 45-570 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, hereby gives notice of a public hearing on the proposed management plan for the Prescott Active Management Area for the fourth management period, 2010 to 2020 (Proposed Plan). A map showing the location of the Prescott Active Management Area (PRAMA) follows this notice.

The Proposed Plan contains mandatory conservation requirements and monitoring and reporting requirements for persons withdrawing, distributing or receiving groundwater within the PRAMA. These requirements, which are set forth in the Agricultural Conservation Program, the Municipal Conservation Program and the Industrial Conservation Program of the Proposed Plan, are designed to achieve reductions in withdrawals of groundwater within the AMA. The Proposed Plan also includes an Augmentation and Recharge Program, a Water Management Assistance Program, an introductory chapter, and chapters discussing water resources, water use characteristics, groundwater quality, plan implementation, water budgets and projections, and water management strategy.
