Dale,

The temporary prohibition is on irrigation of new lands. There is no prohibition on drilling wells or clearing land. ADWR is not aware of the irrigation of 2000 acres of new land by a petitioner. Also note that lands that were irrigated within the five years prior to March 18, 2015 may be changed from one crop such as alfalfa to another crop such as an orchard.
