Sirs:

It would be advisable to have here a list of the lands which are offered for sale on the Salt River project, together with a statement of the prices asked or value of the lands. I suggest a statement about as follows:

John Jones, 40 acres, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 3, T. 5 N., R. 27 E. Has cultivated 20 acres; has house of 4 rooms, valued at \$500; small barn. Will sell at \$30 per acre. Crops raised are oats, barley, alfalfa and potatoes.

John Smith, will sell relinquishment on E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 1, etc. No improvements. Land plowed once; soil light, sandy clay, suitable for grain. Will sell relinquishment for \$200.

I should be glad to have advice from you as to the practicability of keeping us informed from week to week of changes in such a list of lands sold and of other lands offered for sale, so that we may have in the Washington office a list of these lands available for examination by persons who come here and to form the basis of replies to the hundreds of letters which come in concerning opportunities for settlement.
