**PLEDGE OF LONG-TERM STORAGE CREDITS TO AREA OF HYDROLOGIC IMPACT  
FOR CERTIFICATE OF ASSURED WATER SUPPLY**

\_\_\_\_\_ holds Area of Hydrologic Impact Recovery Well Permit No. 74-\_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ (“AOHI Permit”). The AOHI Permit requires that \_\_\_\_\_ acre-feet of long  
term storage credits (“LTSCs”) must be maintained in Long Term Storage Account No. 70-  
\_\_\_\_\_ (“LTSC Account”), for the location(s) of recovery of the stored water  
determined to be within the area of hydrologic impact of the stored water as identified in  
the AOHI Permit.

All wells determined to be within the area of hydrologic impact of the stored water in the  
AOHI Permit have also been included as recovery wells in Application for Certificate of  
Assured Water Supply No. \_\_\_\_\_ (“Certificate”).

The undersigned acknowledges that \_\_\_\_\_ acre-feet of LTSCs must be maintained in the  
LTSC Account for the location(s) of recovery of stored water determined to be within the  
area of hydrologic impact as identified in the AOHI Permit, in addition to any LTSCs to be  
recovered as part of the water supply for the Certificate.

The undersigned acknowledges that, pursuant to A.R.S. § 45-853.01(A)(1) and § 45-  
855.01(C), \_\_\_\_\_ acre-feet of LTSCs are required to be maintained in storage at permitted  
facility No. \_\_\_\_\_, are not recoverable for a period of at least 100 years  
after the Certificate is issued and are not assignable except for the benefit of the  
subdivision. To the extent that the LTSCs may be transferred or assigned, the LTSCs will  
remain subject to these limitations.
