**DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY:** The Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) hereby provides notice of the United States' application deficiencies related to certain Potential Water Rights (PWRs) found within Watershed File Report (WFR) No. 111-20-032, discrepancies related to filings associated with PWRs found within WFR Nos. 111-20-

1 032 and 112-17-063, and requests for the Court to set amended deadlines for the United  
2 States and ADWR.

6 **A. WFR No. 111-20-032, Associated Amendment Applications, and Scheduled**  
7 **Meeting**

8 On March 3, 2025 the Court filed its [Order Approving United States Proposed](#)  
9 [Schedule with Modification](#), wherein it requested ADWR to “produce revised CWRs and  
10 amended WFRs by September 22, 2025” following submissions by the United States for  
11 revisions and/or amendments for certain CWRs by April 28, 2025.<sup>1</sup> While the United States  
12 timely submitted their applications, ADWR has found the applications to be incorrect after  
13 investigation by two Water Resources Specialists and review of that investigation by the  
14 Surface Water Section Supervisor. The deficiencies found therein are numerous and  
15 complicated, and ADWR notified the applicant of them on Friday, September 5, 2025 (*see*  
16 Attachment A). ADWR also requested to meet with a technical specialist from the United  
17 States Bureau of Land Management to discuss the deficiencies, which is scheduled to occur  
18 on September 16, 2025 at 11:00am.

20 **B. Discrepancies Amongst Filings Related to PWR Nos. 111-20-032-WL001, 111-**  
21 **20-032-WL002, 111-20-032-WL003, 111-20-032-WL005, 111-20-032-WL009,**  
22 **112-17-063-SW001, and 112-17-063-SW002**

23 While preparing to amend WFR Nos. 111-20-032 and 112-17-063, ADWR  
24 examined the San Pedro River Watershed HSR published in 1991; filings, applications,

1 registrations, and claims found within ADWR's Surface Water Filings Database; the most  
2 current Statement of Claimant related to each PWR; the United States' Suggested  
3 Corrections to Proposed Abstracts filed on January 27, 2023, and the Proposed Abstracts  
4 found therein. Attachment B illustrates the discrepancies found during that investigation.

5 **C. Request for Deadlines**

6 Thus, ADWR respectfully requests for the Court to set new deadlines for the  
7 following: (1) for the United States to file corrected applications to amend the CWRs  
8 identified in Attachment A; (2) for ADWR to process those corrected applications; and (3)  
9 for ADWR to submit Amended WFR Nos. 111-20-032 and 112-17-063 thirty days after  
10 ADWR has issued revised Certificates of Water Right. Should the Court deny this request,  
11 ADWR is prepared to file the Amended WFR Nos. 11-20-032 and 112-17-063 and  
12 accompanying reports detailing the issues found during their investigation by the original  
13 September 22, 2025, deadline.

Enclosed please find the submitted Amendments that you filed for the above-referenced surface water filings. At this time, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("Department") is unable to process the Amendments because additional information, clarifications, and corrections are required.

The named beneficial use, quantities, measurements, and legal location should be consistent with approved abstracts and orders. Please revise the Amendment Forms to only correct attributes incorrectly presented in the current applications or certificates.

- A. **W1-11-232\_ Potential Water Right ("PWR") 111-20-032-WL001 for Graveyard Gulch Spring:** The Amendment, Revised Certificate of Water Right No. 2766.0001 (*Application No. A-4019.0002*) and amended Statement of Claimant No. 39-674 are inconsistent as the listed beneficial use, quantities, point of diversion and place of use do not match.
- B. **W1-11-232\_ PWR 111-20-032-WL002 for Moson Spring:** The Amendment, Revised Certificate of Water Right No. 2767.0001 (*Application No. A-4020.0002*) and Statement of Claimant No. 39-675, are inconsistent as the listed beneficial use, quantities, point of diversion and place of use do not match.
- C. **W1-11-232\_ 111-20-032-WL003 for Murray Spring:** The Amendment, Revised Certificate of Water Right No. 2768 (*Application No. A-4021.0002*) and amended Statement of Claimant No. 39-676 are inconsistent as the beneficial use, quantities, point of diversion and place of use do not match.
- D. **W1-11-232\_ 111-20-032-WL005 for Lewis Spring:** The Amendment, Revised Certificate of Water Right No. 2770.0001 (*Application No. 4A-4023*) and amended Statement of Claimant

No. 39-678 are inconsistent as the beneficial use, quantities, point of diversion and place of use do not match.

- E. **W1-11-232\_ 111-20-032-WL009 for Meusel Spring:** The Amendment, Certificate of Water Right No. 95392.0000 (Application No. 33-95392.0000), Statement of Claimant Nos. 39-13992 and 39-14505 are inconsistent as the beneficial use, quantities, point of diversion and place of use do not match.


1. Provide the USGS Topographic map or equivalent clearly showing the proposed point of diversion, any conveyance system, and the place(s) of use for each Amendment requested.
2. A copy of the recorded deed or official document showing land ownership in the name of the United States on Behalf of the Department of the Interior Bureau of Land Management.

Amendment procedure is provided to allow a water user the opportunity to correct facts which were incorrectly presented in the original document or request changes in place of use. Please be aware that an Amendment to an Application for a Permit to Appropriate Public Waters of the State of Arizona or to Construct a Reservoir may not be used to make changes in location, source, increase quantity, or use of water that have occurred since the date of first beneficial use stated on the original application.

The Department would like to schedule a technical meeting to discuss the deficiencies identified above. The Department encourages the Bureau of Land Management to include any technical specialists and consultants who are familiar with the complexity of the corrections required.

RE: Certificate of Water Right Amendments

The Arizona Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has been reviewing the agency's surface water claims in the San Pedro River National Conservation Area (SPRNCA) pursuant to the Special Master's orders in adjudication contested case no. W1-11-232. The Special Master has ordered that amendments be filed with the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) to revise or amend several Certificates of Water Right (CWR).

Please accept the amendments to the following CWRs, CWR No. 2766 (4A-4019), CWR No. 2767 (4A-4020), CWR No. 2768 (4A-4020), CWR No. 2770 (4A-4023), CWR No. 33-95392.

**CWR No. 2766** - A mapping error needs to be corrected. The correct location is SENWSW 2 T21S R21E.

**CWR No. 2767** - A mapping error needs to be corrected. The correct location is SWSWNW 13 T21S R21E.

**CWR No. 2768** - I believe this amendment has already been submitted to ADWR and the certificate has been re-issued.

**CWR No. 2770** - A mapping error needs to be corrected. The correct location is NWSESW 29 T21S R22E. I understand that our previous amendment for this CWR was not accepted. However, it should have been. There is no spring location in the original listed location of SWNW 29 T21S R22E. A field survey from 2003 and 2022 puts the actual location as NWSESW. The difference in names (original was Lewis Springs, newest amendment changes to Lewis Springs South) is due to having a more detailed inventory of the area.

**CWR No. 33-95392** - A mapping error needs to be corrected. The correct location is NWSWSW 31 T21S R22E.
