Thomas Buschatzke, Director of the Arizona Department of Water Resources (“Director”) hereby issues, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes, sections 45-569, 45-570, and 45-571, the following statement as the Proposed Management Goal for the Douglas Active Management Area:

“The management goal of the Douglas AMA is to support the general economy and welfare of water users in the basin by attempting to reduce the rate of aquifer depletion by 2035 and every 10 years thereafter.”

The Director proposes to adopt this goal, with any modifications made in response to public comments, as the Douglas Active Management Area Management Goal.
