NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE PUBLIC WATER

In the matter of application assigned number 33-200023, Douglas D. Bundy, has filed an Application for Permit to Appropriate Public Water dated October 7, 2025.

The application states:

1. Source of Water: Grampa Bundy's Spring & Crocodile Bundy's Spring, a tributary to the Colorado River watershed.
2. Proposed use and amount: 54,050 gallons per annum for stockwatering use and 7,300 gallons per annum for wildlife use.
3. Point of diversion: The Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 12, Township 34 North, Range 9 West, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Mohave County, Arizona.
4. Place of use: The Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 25, Township 35 North, Range 9 West, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Mohave County, Arizona.
5. Description of dam and reservoir: The vertical dam height at downstream face is 4 feet with a storage capacity of 415 acre-feet. Water delivered by pipe for the capacity for each foot in depth is 12 cubic feet to be stored in Wood Reservoir.

SUBMITTED MAPS AVAILABLE AT THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

Protests to the issuance of the Permit to Appropriate Public Water may be filed by any person who alleges that the proposed appropriation conflicts with vested water rights, is a menace to public safety, or is against the interests and welfare of the public. Protests must be submitted either in writing or on a form provided by the Department to the Arizona Department of Water Resources, Surface Water Permitting Section, 1110 W. Washington Street, Suite 310, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, within sixty (60) days after the date of issuance of the Notice. A copy of the stated protests must also be forwarded to the applicant.

The Notice is issued this 1st day of July, 2026.

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
