NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE PUBLIC WATER

In the matter of application assigned number 33-200030, U.S. Army Yuma Proving Ground, 301 C St. Bldg. 307 Yuma, Arizona 85365, has filed an Application for Permit to Appropriate Public Water dated March 5, 2026.

The application states:

1. Source of Water: An unnamed wash, a tributary to an unnamed wash within the Lower Gila River watershed.
2. Proposed use and amount: Legacy Tank (Site A) - 10,580 gallons per annum and Legacy Tank (Site B) - 23,440 gallons per annum for wildlife use(s) for a total annual amount of 34,020 gallons per annum.
3. Point of diversion: The Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 7, Township 4 South, Range 14 West, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Yuma County, Arizona.
4. Place of use: The Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 7, Township 4 South, Range 14 West, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Yuma County, Arizona.
5. Description of storage and works: Legacy Tank (Site A) - 2 concrete collection point dams 1-foot tall by 10-feet long, will not hold water but channel it through two 6-inch pipes, 150-foot long and 65-foot long to an underground tank with a storage capacity of 9,780 gallons and an 800 gallon trough. Legacy (Site B) - 2 concrete collection point dams 1-foot tall by 20-feet long, will not hold water but channel it through two 6-inch pipes, 110-foot long and 200-foot long to 5 underground 24-inch diameter by 200-foot long PVC pipes with a storage capacity of 23,000 gallons and a 440 gallon trough.

SUBMITTED MAPS AVAILABLE AT THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

Protests to the issuance of the Permit to Appropriate Public Water may be filed by any person who alleges that the proposed appropriation conflicts with vested water rights, is a menace to public safety, or is against the interests and welfare of the public. Protests must be submitted either in writing or on a form provided by the Department to the Arizona Department of Water Resources, Surface Water Permitting Section, 1110 W. Washington Street, Suite 310, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, within sixty (60) days after the date of issuance of the Notice. A copy of the stated protests must also be forwarded to the applicant.
