AMENDED NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE PUBLIC WATER

In the matter of application assigned number 33-61687, JJJ Corporation, 30350 W. Oro Rd, Prescott, AZ 86305, has filed an amendment to an Application for Permit to Appropriate Public Water filed on March 29, 1978.

The amended application states:

1. Source of Water: North Mountain Hope wash, a tributary to Trout Creek, a tributary of the Bill Williams River within the Bill Williams River watershed.
2. Proposed use and amount: 6,570,000 gallons or 20.1 acre-feet per annum for stockwatering, 35,257,078 gallons or 108.2 acre-feet per annum for recreation and 1,117,125 gallons or 3.4 acre-feet per annum for wildlife use including fish.
3. Point of diversion: An unsurveyed area projected at the West-half of the Northeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{4}$), Section 17, Township 18 North, Range 8 West, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Yavapai County, Arizona.
4. Place of use: An unsurveyed area projected at the West-half of the Northeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{4}$), Section 17, Township 18 North, Range 8 West, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Yavapai County, Arizona.
5. Description of dam and reservoir: Cottonwood Dam, constructed and water first beneficially used August 1, 1941, is composed of an earthen dam with a 18-foot vertical dam height at the downstream face. The capacity for each foot in depth is 7.33 cubic feet with the total storage capacity of the system at 132 acre-feet.

SUBMITTED MAPS AVAILABLE AT THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

Protests to the issuance of the Permit to Appropriate Public Water may be filed by any person who alleges that the proposed appropriation conflicts with vested water rights, is a menace to public safety, or is against the interests and welfare of the public. Protests must be submitted either in writing or on a form provided by the Department to the Arizona Department of Water Resources, Surface Water Permitting Section, 1110 W. Washington Street, Suite 310, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, within sixty (60) days after the date of issuance of the Notice. A copy of the stated protests must also be forwarded to the applicant.

The Amended Notice is issued this 22nd day of June 2026.
